#### **Support the Foundation**

The Foundation Trustees would like to thank all the clubs who sent in the \$300 for the "Build Your Dollars" program by October 1, 2017, in order to participate in the distribution of scholarship funds for the 2018-19 academic year. The amount of the return to your club will be determined by the earnings received on the investment of these dollars. The Carr Investment Group has done an excellent job of investing for the Foundation. The Trustees have been able to return 81% on your investment of \$300. We will be able to give you the exact amount of your return at the 2018 National Convention.

The application for the Foundation Educational Grants have been limited to only five for 2018-19. These grants will be awarded to only the most deserving students. After 2018, the grant program will be phased out.

Encourage students to take part with colleges and universities that have become partners with Ruritans. Any Ruritan scholarship recipient should call Amanda at the Ruritan Foundation Office to see if their College/University is a program participant. If not, the Trustees may be able to sign a partnership with them.

The Trustees have updated and will continue updating the Foundation website. All contributions to the Foundation has a form to be used when sending money in to the National Office.

The 2017 Foundation Fellowship Weekend was a huge success with approximately 200 Ruritans, their families, and guests were in attendance. Galax and the Twin Counties of Carroll and Grayson were honored to have us visit the area. In return, I was glad to show them just what Ruritan does best: AWARD people for their great service to their communities by presenting them with a Tom Downing Fellow Award.

We were able to give 415 Build Your Dollars, 152 Tom Downings and several \$\$\$Million Dollar Awards this year. At Foundation Weekend we took in \$3,470.85 from the auction, TD raffle \$665, and registration \$5,020 with expenses of \$4,025. We feel the Foundation was blessed to have the support of the all who were in attendance. Thank you very much. Each act of kindness will be remembered. Trustees thank each club and individual who have added to their fund and achieved another level in giving.
