Admission at each is \$10 adults, \$8 seniors (55+), and \$5 students.

You could spend a lovely two-stop day reliving American history at Old

Salem and Guilford Courthouse National Military Park. Only a 1 1/4 hour round-trip from the hotel,

> these museums are open 9-4:30. Admission is FREE at the Courthouse, and \$17 adults and \$9 students at Old Salem.



Ready For: The Arts

You could spend a day viewing and buying fine artwork at Seagrove Pottery Center and Bob Timberlake Galleries. At only 1½ hours round-trip from the hotel, you owe it to yourself to visit these art centers open 10–4. Admission is \$2.50 adults and \$1 students at Seagrove Pottery and the Timberlake gallery is FREE.

Ready For: Shopping

You could spend a day shopping at Replacements LTD and the Tanger Outlets in Mebane. Go replace your broken china and finish your school shopping only 1 hour round-trip from the hotel. Replacements LTD. is open on Saturday from 9–6 and Tanger Outlets from 9–9.

Ready For: Fresh Farm Products

You could spend a day finding garden-fresh produce, homemade jellies, and other homemade delights the Piedmont Triad Farmers Market. Only half an hour from the hotel, the Farmers Market is open on Saturday from 7–6.

Ready for: Science

You could spend a day exploring natural wonders at the Greensboro Natural Science Center featuring an aquarium, science museum, and zoo onsite. A 20-minute ride away, the Science Center is open on Saturday from 9–5. The cost is \$13.50 adults and \$12.50 seniors and students.
